He graduated from the **University of Manitoba** and dedicated **25 years** of service to the **Federal Government of Canada**, where he was honoured with the **Service Canada Innovator Award in 2007**.

Jay's passion for community service began at the young age of 17 and remained a lifelong commitment. He dedicated himself to numerous nonprofit and charitable organizations, serving in leadership roles with Hindu Society of Manitoba, Tamil Hindu Group, Folklorama, Vedanta Society of Manitoba, United Way, Liberal Party of Manitoba (Seine River), Liberal Party of Canada (Winnipeg South).
